To the Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights Under Law:

We are writing in response to your Information Quality Act request letter dated July 8, 2020. The Department reviewed your request at that time and prepared a response which was delayed because of the continued response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

At the time of your request, COVID-19 was an emerging, rapidly evolving situation. We updated our guidance in response to your request in August of 2020. We apologize for not notifying you at the time. Since then, we have made a number of other changes and updates to the CDC guidance to which you originally referred and to the website related to your inquiry. Therefore, the correction requests in the letter dated July 8, 2020 no longer applies to the most currently available information.
