

## ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT

The next meeting of the Advisory Council on Alzheimer's Research, Care, and Services will be held on Monday, July 29, 2019 from 9:00am to 5:00pm EDT. The meeting will be held at the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Room 800, Hubert H. Humphrey Building, 200 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, DC 20201, and webcast live on <http://www.hhs.gov/live>. Please allow 45 minutes to go through security and walk to the meeting room.

The Advisory Council will spend the majority of meeting considering recommendations made by each of the three subcommittees to present to the Secretary of HHS and Congress. Additional presentations will include updates on the latest biomedical research findings, an overview of the *Healthy Brain Initiative: The Road Map for Indian Country*, and a discussion of the progress made since 2011 through the National Plan to Address Alzheimer's Disease. Federal workgroups will also provide updates.

**Public Attendance:** Seating is limited. Names need to be put on a list of expected attendees and forwarded to the security officers at HHS. Although the meeting is open to the public, procedures governing security and the entrance to federal buildings may change without notice. Each attendee needs a photo ID to gain entrance into the building.

**Public Input:** Time is allocated in the afternoon on the agenda to hear public comments. The time for oral comments will be limited to two (2) minutes per individual.
