### Our Advocacy

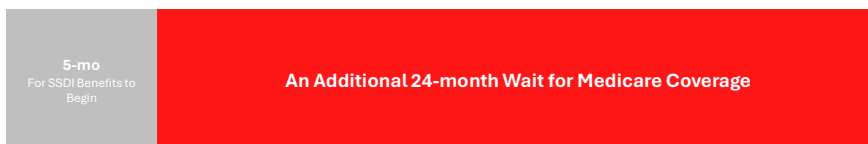
Ensuring FDA-approved Alzheimer's diagnostics and treatments are accessible through Medicare for everyone who needs them.



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## The Problem: 29 Months Without Coverage

Americans under 65 with young-onset Alzheimer's face this delay in coverage

### Why it's harmful:

New therapies work only in the earliest stage — a 2+ year wait can close the treatment window for good.



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## A Legislative Solution is Necessary: The BRIDGE Act

The **Bridging Relief in Delayed Government Enrollment (BRIDGE) for Young Onset Alzheimer's Disease Act of 2025 (HR 6799)** eliminates the waiting periods for people with young-onset Alzheimer's.
