Expert Input on PTAC's Recommendations on Value-Based Care

September 14–15, 2026

Expert Sessions:

PTAC's September 2026 public meeting includes four expert sessions during which the Committee is seeking expert input on PTAC's recommendations presented in its draft white paper titled *Transforming Health Care Delivery Through Value-Based Payment Models and Care: A Roadmap*. During each expert session, each expert will first have an opportunity to provide a 10-minute presentation of their assessment and thoughts related to PTAC's draft white paper.

Committee Discussion and Q&A Session:

After each expert provides a 10-minute presentation, the Committee will facilitate an interactive discussion with the experts. As part of the discussion, Committee members will ask questions, including questions raised in response to the experts' presentations. The following are examples of questions that Committee members may ask.

Question 1: *What is your overall assessment of PTAC's white paper and its value as a roadmap for policymakers to support transformation of the U.S. health care system?*

Question 2: *What are your thoughts on the range of value-based care topics and recommendations covered in the white paper?*

Question 3: *Is the wording and tone of the recommendations appropriate for a wide audience, including health care payers and policymakers?*

Question 4: *Should any recommendations be modified to be made stronger and/or should any recommendations be made less prescriptive?*

Question 5: *Are there any other recommendations that PTAC should consider pertaining to value-based care that would be valuable to policymakers?*

Wrap-Up Question: *Is there any other pertinent information that PTAC should consider including in its white paper to strengthen it?*
