FY20 Budget Status

FY19 enacted level for NIA was \$3.083B

➤ **Senate committee draft includes:**

- An additional \$3B for NIH above FY19 funding levels
- \$3.606B (16.9% increase) for NIA; this figure includes \$350M for AD/ADRD research

➤ **House passed bill (HR 2740) includes:**

- An additional \$2B for NIH above FY19 funding levels
- \$3.356B (8.8% increase) for NIA

- HR 4378 signed on 9/27/19 – funds the Federal government (at FY19 levels) through November 21, 2019

Urgent Need to Improve and Transform Dementia Care

- Initiated by NIH/NIA and awarded in September 2019
- **Goal:** Strengthen the national capacity to implement cost-effective large-scale research studies that engage health care delivery organizations as research partners for people living with dementia (PLWD) and their caregivers (CGs)
- **Vision:** Transform the delivery, quality, and outcomes of care provided to Americans living with dementia and their caregivers by accelerating the testing and adoption of evidence-based interventions within healthcare systems

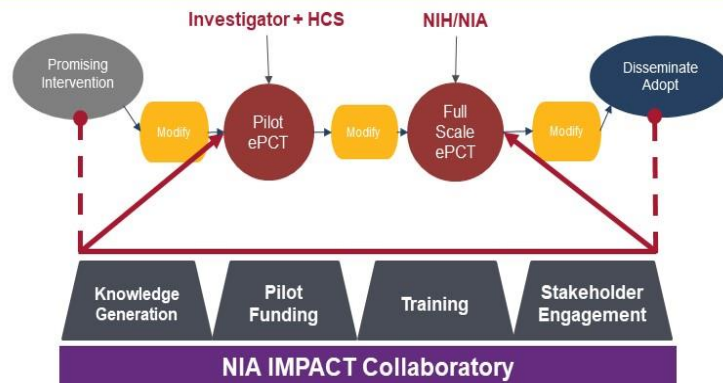


What Will the NIA IMPACT Do?

- Develop and disseminate technical, policy, and best practices
- Enhance research development and investigator capacity:
 - Fund/guide pilot embedded pragmatic clinical trials (ePCTs), support transformation into full-scale ePCTs.
 - Resource for NIA-funded investigators conducting ePCTs in PLWD.
 - Support training through career award, workshops, and on-line modules.
- Engage stakeholders
