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



Persons Turning 65 in 2005




Value of out-of-pocket LTC expenditures at age 65

LTSS need


Percentage of the non-nursing home population age 65 and over who are receiving help with self-care, mobility, or household activities, by dementia status and age, 2011

Level of LTSS need


Level of assistance received by the non-nursing home population age 65 and over with dementia who are receiving assistance, by sex, 2011

Average hours of LTSS


Mean hours of help received in the last month by the non-nursing home population age 65 and over who are receiving assistance, by type of help and dementia status, 2011
