Create a better coordinated, dementia capable system of care within California's Dual Eligibles Demonstration

Project Objectives

- 1. Improve detection and care management of beneficiaries with dementia
- 2. Establish better partnerships between health systems and family/friend caregivers
- 3. Strengthen partnerships between health plans and dementia-specific community-based organizations

Project Overview

The Project seeks to improve health plans' system of care through:

- o Advocacy
- Care manager and Dementia Care Specialist training and support
- Family/friend caregiver education and respite
- Support services through referrals to local Alzheimer's organizations
- o Technical assistance to health plans and government entities to create systems change
