



Anticipated Outcomes

- **Improvement in the dementia capability** of grantees and partners (using ACL Dementia Capability Assessment);
- Increased access to services and supports for **Improved Quality of Life**;
- Increases in the number of trainers trained in **implementation of dementia specific evidence-based and evidence informed interventions**;
 - Increases in the number of persons living with dementia and caregivers benefiting dementia specific evidence-based and evidence informed interventions;
- **Reduction in caregiver burden, stress and increased self-efficacy for caregivers** of persons with ADRD;
- Increases in number of **dementia friendly communities**;
- Increased **capacity to identify individuals with possible ADRD and their caregivers**, and
- Increased in availability of **dementia-capable supports and services to underserved populations**.


- Goal: Identify, develop, and evaluate technology solutions to **support the ability of aging adults with a cognitive impairment (CI) to perform home living and community activities**, and to enhance their independence and community living experience.
- Partners: Weill Cornell Medicine (WCM),
Florida State University (FSU),
University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign (UIUC)
- Funding: \$4.6 million, 2019 – 2024

NHANES DATA REPORT

- Data from National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey
- More than 3,000 adults ≥60 years
- In-person cognitive performance testing
 - Immediate and delayed recall
 - Verbal fluency
 - Digit symbol substitution test
- Subjective cognitive decline (SCD) status
- Adults with SCD had lower average cognitive performance test scores
- Adults with no SCD, in general, did NOT score poorly (lowest 25%) on these tests









- All 50 states plus DC and Puerto Rico at least once in 2015–2018





- Data will be uploaded to [Alzheimer’s Disease and Healthy Aging Data Portal](#) and used to develop [infographics](#) in the coming months





NATIONAL HEALTHY BRAIN INITIATIVE

NOTICE OF FUNDING OPPORTUNITY (NOFO) – FY20

Five year, multi-component announcement for Alzheimer’s and related dementias (ARD) public health activities. NOFO activities are expected to promote brain health, address cognitive impairment including ARD, and support the needs of caregivers (unpaid persons providing care or assistance to someone with ARD).

Component A

- Fund an organization with national scope and reach within states, to develop and implement public health strategies guided by the Healthy Brain Initiative (HBI) Road Map Series.

Component B

- Fund organizations to support populations with a high burden of Alzheimer’s disease and related dementias (ARD).
